TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All Contestants must submit to polygraph test if requested by tournament officials, and abide by said decision.**
- 2. State and Federal boating and fishing regulations apply.**
- 3. No contestants may enter weigh-in line with more than five (5) fish per boat.**
- 4. Fish will be measured with mouth closed on a flat board using golden rule with min. length allowed at 12". Penalty for short fish is loss of short fish and 3 lb penalty to team.**
- 5. Entry fee (based on 2-man team) must be paid prior to fishing on Saturday, April 17, 2010.**
- 6. Team entry fee is \$110.00. Entry fee includes \$10.00 Big Bass Pot. Launch position determined by time entry is received.**
- 7. Mail entry to Michelin Tire Co., PO Box 579, Lexington, S.C. 29072-0579 Must be postmarked by April 9, 2010.**
- 8. Deadline for entry is 6:15am, Saturday, April 17, 2010.**
- 9. Fishing hours are from safe light to 3:00pm. Weigh-in opens at 3:00pm and closes at 3:30pm. Penalty for returning late to weigh in will be assessed at 1 lb/min.**
- 10. Only black bass and spotted bass will be weighed.**
- 11. Fishing only on Lake Murray.**
- 12. All fish must be caught on artificial bait (no Trolling or live bait).**
- 13. Contestants must register at headquarters before fishing.**
- 14. All decisions of tournament officials will be final.**
- 15. Any protest must be presented in writing ten (10) minutes after weigh-in.**
- 16. No iced, frozen fish will be weighed. Dead fish will be penalized ½ lb each at weigh in. No dead fish may be culled during tournament. Maximum number of fish is 6 in boat at any time.**
- 17. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are permitted during Tournament hours.**
- 18. Each contestant must wear a personal flotation device at any time the main engine is running.**
- 19. Contestants sixteen (16) years of age or younger must have signed parental consent form and be accompanied by a duly authorized adult.**
- 20. All persons in the boat must be entered in the tournament.**
- 21. Contestants may fish from boat only.**
- 22. Contestants may launch from anywhere on lake as long as they report to tournament headquarters for registration, livewell check, and start of tournament.**
- 23. All ties will be broken by largest fish in creel. Loser will be dropped one place in standing.**
- 24. Michelin reserves the right to refuse entry to any contestant of a questionable nature.**
- 25. Official clock will be at tournament headquarters.**
- 26. All fish will be released live back into Lake Murray.**
- 27. No fishing within fifty (50) feet of another anchored or tied boat.**
- 28. Contestants may not start before designated launch, but may be on the water before 6:30am.**
- 29. Tournament will be held regardless of weather.**
